Housekeeping:

- Immediately prior to the September meeting, the Board fixed dues for 2019 at \$300 per year. A \$100 increase to cover the cost of the windmill revenues. In accordance with the bylaws, the Board has requested the membership ratify the rate at the October meeting.
- A reminder for our less thoughtful members who visited over the summer. Bottles, cans, tin foil, clam shells and other non-combustibles – there is no magic incinerator at camp. Weather permitting, campers are to be removed from cabin property immediately (or within a reasonable timeframe) upon conclusion of deer season. Our property is not to be used for personal winter storage. Hopefully this reminder will be the end of this increasingly annoying subject.
